Subject: Hazardous Walking Conditions – East Classification Yard

BRC Maintenance of Way forces have started a major tie replacement project in the East Classification Yard.

The goal of the project is to improve operations by raising the leads by anywhere from 12 to 33 inches. This will result in improvements in the way that cars roll in the yard. This will also require a massive amount of ballast, which is being delivered by the South Chicago Assignments daily in our ballast cars.

In addition, tie replacement in the East Classification Yard will take place, with over 700 ties to be replaced in tracks and on the leads.
Work will continue through August of 2019.

While this work is under way, walking conditions may change daily, and various types of ballast will be used in phases as the surfaces are raised.

Be aware of hazardous walking conditions, and M/W equipment in the East End of the East Class Yard during the duration of the project.
