SAFETY RULEBOOK SAF-1:

20.0 WORKING AROUND TRACKS OR BEING ON EQUIPMENT

20.1 Precautions Around Tracks and Moving Equipment

20.1.3 Signals for Movement

After giving a signal to stop the movement, keep clear until the equipment has stopped. Do not give a signal to move equipment if anyone is foul of your movement.

GENERAL CODE OF OPERATING RULES:

1.0 General Responsibilities

1.28 Fire

Employees must take every precaution to prevent loss and damage by fire.

Employees must report promptly to the train dispatcher any fires seen on or near the right of way, unless the fires are being controlled. If there is danger of the fire spreading to a bridge or other structure, crew members must stop their train and help extinguish the fire.

Cause of fire, if known, must be promptly reported.
