SAFETY RULEBOOK SAF-1:

System General Order 2021-001

20.1.2 Precautions near Passing Trains and Equipment (ADDITION)

- Engineering Department employees may stand on one track, when a train is passing on another track, only when the track they are standing on has been identified as a Designated Place of Safety in the On-Track Safety Briefing.

GENERAL CODE OF OPERATING RULES:

6.28 Movement on Other than Main Track

Except when moving on a main track or on a track where a block system is in effect, trains or engines must move at a speed that allows them to stop within half the range of vision short of:

- Train.
 - Engine.
 - Railroad car.
 - Men or equipment fouling the track.
 - Stop signal.

- Derail or switch lined improperly.
